



### **DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS**

Measure water depths at 10', 20' and 30' from your shoreline.

Consider floating docks when depths exceed 6'-7'

How do you plan to use your dock?

For docking your boat/ kayaks?

For swimming and/or entertaining?

How much room do you have to store your docks in the winter? How long is your watercraft?

Will your boat be tied along your dock or by mooring?

Who will be helping you install your dock each year?

Floating docks are easier to install but can be heavier.
